Rochelle Waste Disposal, LLC (33-CA-15298 and 33-RC-5002; 353 NLRB No. 38) Rochelle, IL Oct. 20, 2008. The Board adopted the administrative law judge's finding that the Respondent violated Section 8(a)(3), (4), and (1) of the Act by discharging employee Jeff Jarvis because he supported the Union's organizing efforts and because he testified in a Board representation proceeding.
