PPG INDUSTRIES, INC.'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

COMES NOW Respondent, PPG Industries, Inc. ("PPG" or "respondent") and respectfully requests a fourteen (14) day extension to file exceptions to the supplemental decision of the Administrative Law Judge, and in support thereof says as follows:

1. On September 30, 2008, the Board issued a decision remanding this case to the Administrative Law Judge for reconsideration and further explanation of several credibility determinations.
2. On December 12, 2008, the Administrative Law Judge issued his supplemental decision, which Respondent did not receive until December 17, 2008, making exceptions due on or before **January 9, 2009**
3. Due to the Christmas and New Years' holidays, additional time is needed to file exceptions to the supplemental decision of the Administrative Law Judge. This is the first request for extension made by the Respondent.

4. Accordingly, the parties should be granted a fourteen (14) day extension to file exceptions to the supplemental decision of the Administrative Law Judge, up to and including **January 23, 2009**.
