REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE EXCEPTIONS AND BRIEF

Charging Party, Cement Masons Local 1, International Union of Bricklayers and Allied Craft Workers, AFL-CIO (“BAC Local 1”) hereby requests a two week extension of time to file Exceptions and Brief in Support in the above matter for the following reasons:

1. The ALJ’s Decision in this matter issued on May 27, 2009 and was received by the undersigned counsel on June 1, 2009.
2. The current due date for exceptions is June 24, 2009.
3. The undersigned counsel, who has had sole responsibility for this case throughout, will be out of the country on a long-scheduled trip from Friday, June 12 through Monday, June 22. Counsel has an extremely heavy schedule the week prior and the week following that trip, including bargaining on June 9 and 10, an oral argument in the Sixth Circuit in Cincinnati on the morning of June 12, and an NLRB trial scheduled for three days beginning on June 24. Accordingly, counsel requires a two week extension in order to have sufficient time to adequately prepare and file
