ORDER DENYING MOTION TO INTERVENE

On June 23, 2009, the Pacific Maritime Association ("PMA") filed a Motion to Intervene ("Motion") in this case seeking to appear as an Intervenor at the hearing scheduled to begin on June 30, 2009, in Seattle, Washington.

On June 25, 2009, International Longshore and Warehouse Union ("ILWU") submitted its position in support of PMA's Motion. That same day, the Machinists District Lodge 160, Local Lodge 289 ("Machinists") submitted its position opposing PMA's Motion. SSA Marine ("Employer") expressed no objection to the Motion.

Having carefully considered the positions of the parties, I conclude there has been no demonstration that the interests of PMA could be adversely impacted by any remedy arising out of this proceeding. Moreover, to the extent PMA may have evidence that would be relevant and material to this matter, any party to this proceeding

is free to call PMA representatives in possession of such evidence. Accordingly, the Motion is denied.
