**JOINT REQUEST FOR EXTENSION  
OF TIME TO FILE POST-HEARING BRIEFS**

International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 150 (“Local 150”), AFL-CIO, by counsel and pursuant to Section 102.111 of the National Labor Relations Board’s Rules and Regulations, hereby files this joint request for an extension of time to file post-hearing briefs in the above-captioned matter. In support of this request, Local 150 states as follows:

1. On July 14 through 16, 2009, Region 13 held and completed a hearing pursuant to Section 10(k) of the Act, 29 U.S.C. § 160(k).

2. At the close of the hearing, the parties requested that the court reporter expedite the preparation of the transcript. Despite the parties' request, the court reporter advised the parties that the transcript would not be completed until the week of July 20, 2009. As of the time of filing this Motion, the parties have yet to receive the transcript of the proceedings.

3. Pursuant to Section 102.90 of the Board's Rules and Regulations, post-hearing briefs are currently due in this matter on July 23, 2009.

4. Due to the press of other matters, in addition to the fact that the parties have yet to receive the transcript, Counsel for the respective parties will not be able to complete and submit their briefs by the current due date.

5. Based on the foregoing, the parties request jointly that the time for submitting post-hearing briefs to the Board be extended by 30 days; that is the parties request that the Board extend the due date for briefs to August 23, 2009.

6. Counsel for Local 150 represents that Counsel for the Employer and Counsel for the United Union of Roofers, Water-Proofers, and Allied Workers, Local No. 11, join in this request. Laborers International Union, Local 4, allegedly disclaimed interest in the disputed work prior to the hearing and did not participate in the hearing.

7. This request is therefore being made more than three days before the date for submission of post-hearing briefs to the Board.

8. This request is not being made to prejudice any of the parties or delay the proceedings.

WHEREFORE, Local 150 respectfully requests that the due date for submission of post-hearing briefs in the above-captioned matter be extended to August 23, 2009.
