EXCEPTIONS


Counsel for the General Counsel respectfully requests permission to exceed the page limit set forth in Section 102.46(j) of the Board's Rules and Regulations. On October 28, 2009, Respondents filed their Exceptions and Brief in Support of Exceptions. The deadline for Counsel for the General Counsel to file an answering brief to Respondents' Exceptions is November 12, 2009. Respondents' Exceptions and Brief in Support of Exceptions contain broad allegations and raise multiple issues to which Counsel for the General Counsel must respond. Additionally, the underlying hearing in this matter spanned 13 days, covered multiple allegations and complex issues, and resulted in a voluminous record of over 2,300 pages of transcript and numerous exhibits. Due to the number of allegations and massive record, Counsel for the General Counsel's Brief to the Administrative Law Judge consisted of approximately 200 pages. Based on the foregoing, Counsel for the General Counsel anticipates that an answering brief to Respondents' Exceptions will require it to exceed the Board's page limitations. Accordingly, Counsel for the General Counsel respectfully requests permission to submit an answering brief to Respondents' Exceptions not to exceed 200 pages.

Counsel for the General Counsel also anticipates that it will file Cross-Exceptions to Administrative Law Judge James M. Kennedy's decision in the instant case. The deadline for Counsel for the General Counsel to file Cross-Exceptions and a brief in support of Cross-Exceptions is November 12, 2009. For the reasons set forth above, Counsel for the General

Counsel also respectfully requests permission to submit a brief in support of Cross-Exceptions not to exceed 100 pages.


