Dear Mr. Heltzer:

I write on behalf of the General Counsel, Respondent and the Union to request a four week extension of time to file answering briefs to Respondent and the Union's exceptions to Administrative Law Judge Lana Parke's decision. Exceptions in Case 21-CA-38735 were originally due on January 6, 2010 but two extensions of time were granted, moving the filing date to March 1, 2010. Answering briefs to exceptions are currently due on March 15, 2010. The parties jointly request that the deadline be moved to April 12, 2010.

Last week Respondent and the Union entered into a non-Board settlement with regard to the charge in Case 21-CA-38735. The four alleged discriminatees named in the charge, who were represented by private counsel, also entered into non-Board settlements with Respondent with regard to the charge in Case 21-CA-38735 and any potential claims under California law. Earlier this week, the Union requested to withdraw the underlying charge in Case 21-CA-38735 based on the foregoing non-Board settlements.

In the next couple of days, Counsel for the General Counsel will be submitting to the Executive Secretary, a joint motion requesting to have Case 21-CA-38735 remanded to the Regional Director in order to process these non-Board settlements. Respondent and the Union have agreed to withdraw their exceptions if and when the case is remanded to the Regional Director. Because settlement of this case is imminent, the parties make this request in order to allow additional time to process and finalize these non-Board settlements. Thank you for considering this request.
