Unpublished Board Decisions in Representation Cases

Airtex Air Conditioning and Heating, Inc. (20-RC-18277) Rancho Cordova, CA, June 21, 2010. No exceptions having been filed to the Regional Director's report recommending disposition of objections to an election held January 13, 2010, the Board adopted the Regional Director's findings and recommendations, and found that a decision and order remanding proceeding to Regional Director for further appropriate action should be issued. Petitioner – Sheet Metal Workers International Association, Local 162.

Kandiyohi County (18-WH-18) Willmar, MN, June 22, 2010. On April 1, 2010, Law Enforcement Labor Services, Inc., filed with the Regional Director a request for certification of representative as bona fide under Section 7(b) of the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 (FLSA), 29 U.S.C. Section 207(b). No party having shown cause why the requested certification should not be issued, the Board certified that Law Enforcement Labor Services, Inc. is a bona fide representative. Petitioner – Law Enforcement Labor Services, Inc.

Screen Actors Guild (31-UC-351) Los Angeles, CA, June 23, 2010. Order affirming Petitioner's request for review of Regional Director's administrative dismissal of petition. Petitioner – an Individual. Chairman Liebman and Members Becker and Pearce participated.

WGN Television (13-RC-21929) Chicago, IL, June 23, 2010. Order denying Employer's request for review of Regional Director's decision and direction of election. Petitioner – International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 1220. Chairman Liebman and Members Becker and Pearce participated.

Airtex Air Conditioning and Heating, Inc. (20-RC-18277) Rancho Cordova, CA, June 24, 2010. On June 21, 2010, the Board inadvertently issued a Decision and Order in proceeding. Accordingly, the Board's Decision and Order issued on June 21, 2010 is rescinded. Petitioner – Sheet Metal Workers International Association, Local 162.

Cargill Meat Solutions Corporation (30-RC-6773) Milwaukee, WI, June 23, 2010. Order denying Employer's request for review of Regional Director's Decision and Direction of Election. Petitioner – International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 494. Chairman Liebman and Members Becker and Pearce participated.

Columbia River Mental Health Services (36-UC-307) Vancouver, WA, June 23, 2010. Order denying Employer's request for review of Regional Director's decision and order. Member Schaumber dissenting: would grant Employer's request for review. Petitioner – Washington State Council of County and City Employees, Council No. 2, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, Local 2699. Chairman Liebman and Members Schaumber and Becker participated.

Vatterott Educational Centers, Inc. (14-RC-12738) St. Louis, MO, June 23, 2010. Order denying both Employer's request for review of Regional Director's decision and direction of election and motion to reopen record. Member Schaumber dissenting: would grant Employer's request for review. Petitioner – United Association for Journeymen and Apprentices of the Plumbing & Pipe Fitting Industry of the United States and Canada, AFL-CIO, Local 562. Chairman Liebman and Members Schaumber and Becker participated.
