
**COUNSEL FOR THE ACTING GENERAL COUNSEL'S
LIMITED EXCEPTIONS TO THE
ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S DECISION AND ORDER**

On June 10, 2010, the Honorable Lana H. Parke, herein called the ALJ, issued her decision in the above-captioned cases. Pursuant to Section 102.46 of the Board's Rules and Regulations, Series 8, as amended, Counsel for the Acting General Counsel of the National Labor Relations Board hereby files the following limited exceptions to the Administrative Law Judge's Decision and Order.¹

¹ All citations to the Administrative Law Judge's Decision will be referred to as "ALJD" followed by the page number, and then the line number(s).

1. To the ALJ's failure to order that Respondent take the following affirmative action necessary to effectuate the policies of the Act: rescind and revoke its overbroad work rules and its mandatory arbitration rule that requires employees to waive their right to file charges with the Board. (ALJD 23:26 – 24:15)
2. To the ALJ's failure to recommend that the Notice to Employees also be posted in Spanish. (ALJD 24:1-12).


