MOTION FOR REMAND

The Region has been advised that the Board's Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter, reported at 353 NLRB No. 32 (9/30/08), will be remanded to the Board by the United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit as a result of the Supreme Court's decision in *New Process Steel v. NLRB*. In this regard, on July 20, 2010, the Charging Party requested withdrawal of the charge as a result of a non-Board settlement with Respondent. The non-Board settlement includes the successful negotiation of a collective bargaining agreement.

In light of the foregoing, Counsel for the General Counsel requests that upon the Board's receipt of the remand from the Second Circuit, the Board remand this case to the Regional Director for appropriate action in light of the non-Board settlement and the related withdrawal request.
