TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S DECISION**


On June 30, 2010, Acting General Counsel Solomon determined that complaint should issue in the above-referenced case. Accordingly, the case was tried in September before Administrative Law Judge Lana H. Parke. On November 30, 2010, Judge Parke issued her decision finding, among other things, that Respondent, SABO, Inc., d/b/a Hoodview Vending Co., did not unlawfully discharge employee LaDonna George for engaging in Union or protected concerted activity. The deadline for filing exceptions to Judge Parke's decision is December 28, 2010.

Counsel for the Acting General Counsel respectfully requests an extension of time to file exceptions to Tuesday, January 18, 2011. This request is based on learning yesterday, December 20, that the Acting General Counsel has determined that exceptions are warranted; the intervening holidays; and on Counsel for the General Counsel's pressing trial preparations in another unrelated matter scheduled for trial on

January 4, 2011. Moreover, Counsel for Respondent and the representative for the Charging Party Union do not oppose this request.

In light of the above, Counsel for the Acting General Counsel requests that the request for an extension to Tuesday, January 18, 2011, be granted.
