**Unopposed Motion by
Counsel for the Acting General Counsel and the Charging Parties
to Extend the Due Date for Both Cross-Exceptions and Answering Briefs**

Counsel for the Acting General Counsel joined by Charging Parties United Steel, Paper and Forestry, Rubber, Manufacturing, Energy, Allied Industrial and Service Workers International Union and its Local Union 14425 respectfully request the Board to extend the filing date for both cross-exceptions and answering briefs to Thursday, September 29, 2011. On September 1, 2011, counsel for the Respondent Employer represented that the Respondent does not oppose this motion.

1. On August 1, 2011, the Honorable Administrative Law Judge Margaret G. Brakebusch issued her Decision (ALJD.) Under the Board’s Rules and Regulations exceptions were due by August 29, 2011; Respondent filed exceptions. Any cross-exceptions or answering briefs are now due September 12, 2011. This motion requesting

an extension of the due date for cross-exceptions and answering briefs until September 29, seeks less than three weeks of additional time.

2. Respondent's exceptions address a factually dense record of in excess of 1,200 pages of transcript and numerous exhibits. The ALJD sets forth that Respondent committed serious unfair labor practices, including a variety of violations of Section 8(a)(1) and (5) of the Act and the refusal to reinstate unfair labor practice strikers. Further, the press of other assignments will substantially consume the undersigned attorney's time during the month of September 2011.

3. In view of the above, counsel the Acting General Counsel joined by the Charging Parties respectfully request the Board to extend the filing date for both cross-exceptions and answering briefs to Thursday, September 29, 2011.
