**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE EXCEPTIONS  
TO THE SUPPLEMENTAL DECISION**

Charging Party International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 150, AFL-CIO (“Local 150”) hereby, for the reasons that follow, requests a two week extension, until Friday, May 4, 2012 for the parties to file exceptions to Administrative Law Judge Amchan’s Supplemental decision on remand.

1. Since the issuance of the ALJ’s supplemental decision, Local 150 and Republic Services Inc. have been working diligently to finalize a global settlement to resolve all outstanding labor issues between them.

2. Since the prior granted extension, Local 150 and Republic Services Inc. have made additional significant progress towards a final global settlement that would include resolution of this case. There is still ongoing discussion, though, regarding backpay amounts due the grievants in the associated arbitration cases. Local 150 and Republic Services Inc. also still need to finalize the settlement language.

3. The backpay and language issues are very close to being resolved. It is anticipated that Local 150 and Republic Services Inc. will reach a final agreement within a week's time. Thereafter, the settlement will be forwarded to Region 25 for review.

4. This extension request is being made for the sole purpose of aiding a global labor settlement between Local 150 and Republic Services Inc.

5. On April 17, 18, 19, 2012, Counsel for Local 150 contacted Counsel for the Acting General Counsel and opposing counsel about this extension request. They do not object.

6. No party will be prejudiced by an additional extension.

WHEREFORE, Charging Party Local 150 respectfully requests a two week extension, until Friday, May 4, 2012 to file exceptions to the Supplemental Decision.
