## NOTICE AND INVITATION TO FILE BRIEFS

*Bashas' Food City*, 28-CA-21435, *Atlantic Scaffolding Company*, 16-CA-26108, and *Kentucky River Medical Center*, 9-CA-42249 are currently pending before the Board on exceptions to the judge's decision. The Board has made no decision on the merits of the allegations. Because the remedial issue set forth below has been raised in these cases, however, the parties and interested amici are invited to file briefs addressing this issue:

Should the Board routinely order compound interest on backpay and other monetary awards in unfair labor practice cases, and, if so, what should be the standard period for compounding (e.g., daily, quarterly, annually)?

Briefs shall be filed with the Board in Washington, D.C., on or before June 11, 2010 addressing this issue. Briefs should not exceed 25 pages in length. The parties may file responsive briefs on or before June 25, 2010, which shall not exceed 10 pages in length. No other responsive briefs will be accepted. No extensions of time will be granted for filing briefs or responsive briefs. The parties and amici should file briefs electronically at <http://mynlrb.nlr.gov/efile>.
