Dear Mr. Heltzer:

Our Firm represents 800 River Road Operating Company, LLC d/b/a Woodcrest Health Care Center ("Employer") in the above-captioned case.

On March 16, 2012, the Employer filed timely Objections to Conduct Affecting the Results of the Election ("Objections") held on March 9, 2012.<sup>1</sup> On April 17, 2012, the Acting Regional Director issued a Report on Objections and Notice of Hearing wherein the Region granted a hearing on two of the Employer's Objections and recommended that the Board overrule the remaining 10 Objections. Pursuant to the Board's Rules, our Request for Review of and Exceptions to the Acting Regional Director's Report currently is due on Tuesday, May 1, 2012.

The Employer respectfully requests a one-week extension of time through and including May 8, 2012 in which to file its Request for Review of and Exceptions to the Acting Regional Director's Report. This extension is necessary due to the fact the New Jersey State Department of Health appeared at the Employer's facility this morning to begin an unannounced survey inspection of the Employer. Our client representatives who are
