**JOINT MOTION FOR A FOUR-WEEK EXTENSION OF TIME FOR THE
PARTIES TO FILE ANSWERING BRIEFS**

Pursuant to Section 102.46 of the Board’s Rules and Regulations, Counsel for the Acting General Counsel (“AGC”) and Respondent Amglo Kemlite (“Amglo” or “Company”), hereby move for a four-week extension of time for the parties to file their respective Answering briefs. In support thereof, Amglo states the following:

1. The Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) decision in this matter was issued on March 22, 2012.
2. On May 2, 2012, the AGC filed Exceptions to the ALJ’s decision.
3. On May 16, 2012, Amglo filed Cross-Exceptions to the ALJ’s decision.
4. Amglo’s Answering Brief is currently due on May 31, 2012. The AGC’s Answering Brief is currently due on May 30, 2012.
5. Amglo and Region 13 have recently begun settlement discussions. While settlement discussions are ongoing, the parties wish to focus on those discussions rather than additional litigation. Accordingly, the parties respectfully seek a four-week extension of time to file their answering briefs, to June 28, 2012 (for both parties).

For all the foregoing reasons, the parties respectfully request that their motion be granted, and that the time in which to file answering briefs be extended for both parties to June 28, 2012.
