Dear Executive Secretary Heltzer:

This firm represents 1199 SEIU United Healthcare Workers East (“Union”). By letter dated June 20, 2012, 800 River Road Operating Company, LLC d/b/a Woodcrest Health Care Center (“Employer”) requested a second extension for the filing of their exceptions to the Hearing Officer’s Report on Objections issued in the above-captioned case. The Union did not oppose the Employer’s first request for an extension, which was granted.

However, the Union opposes the Employer’s request for a second extension which would further delay resolution of this matter. The Employer’s request is not based on any unanticipated circumstances that make a second extension appropriate. Nor has the Employer explained why three business days (and five calendar days), rather than a shorter extension, are required to finalize their submission. Further delay is prejudicial to the interests of the Union and will create scheduling conflicts for Union counsel. For these reasons, the Union opposes the Employer’s request for a second extension.
