Dear Mr. Remar:

This is in response to the the Intervenor's Motion to Strike a Portion of its Brief Submitted to the Administrative Law Judge in the above-named case, which was filed with the Office of the Executive Secretary on June 12, 2012.

Section 102.45(b) of the Board's Rules and Regulations specifies the documents that constitute the record in an unfair labor practice case. These documents include the charge upon which the complaint was issued, the complaint, notice of hearing, answer, motions, rulings, orders, the stenographic report of the hearing, stipulations, exhibits, documentary evidence, and depositions, together with the judge's decision and exceptions, and any cross-exceptions or answering briefs. A party's post-hearing brief to the administrative law judge is not in this list of documents, and is not included in the official record of a case.

Because the Intervenor's post-hearing brief to Judge William Kocol is not part of the record here, the Intervenor's June 12 Motion to Strike will not be forwarded to the Board for its consideration.
