DECISION AND ORDER REMANDING

The National Labor Relations Board has considered objections to an election held July 23, 2008, and the Regional Director's Report recommending disposition of them.¹ The election was conducted pursuant to Stipulated Election Agreement. The tally of ballots shows that 106 votes were cast for and 123 against the Union, with 13 challenged ballots, which is an insufficient number to affect the results.

The Board has reviewed the Regional Director's Report and the Union's exceptions and brief, and has adopted the Regional Director's findings and recommendations.²

¹ Effective midnight December 28, 2007, Members Liebman, Schaumber, Kirsanow, and Walsh delegated to Members Liebman, Schaumber, and Kirsanow, as a three-member group, all of the Board's powers in anticipation of the expiration of the terms of Members Kirsanow and Walsh on December 31, 2007. Pursuant to this delegation, Chairman Schaumber and Member Liebman constitute a quorum of the three-member group. As a quorum, they have the authority to issue decisions and orders in unfair labor practice and representation cases. See Sec. 3(b) of the Act.
