GENERAL COUNSEL'S MOTION TO RESCHEDULE
REOPENING OF HEARING

On July 3, 2012, the National Labor Relations Board, hereafter the Board, issued its Decision and Order in the captioned matter, wherein it remanded to the Administrative Law Judge, hereafter ALJ, the issue of four employees disciplined under Respondents' no access policy.

On July 24, 2012, pursuant to the Board's remand, the ALJ issued an Order scheduling the reopening of this matter for August 13, 2012; however, Counsel for the Acting General Counsel, hereafter GC, is not available on said date due to pre-arranged vacation plans as well as current caseload. In addition, counsels for Respondent-USC University Hospital and Charging Party National Union of Healthcare Workers ("NUHW"), who join in this motion, are not available on said date because they, too, have either scheduling conflicts or pre-arranged vacation plans.

The remaining parties' positions on this request are:

- Respondent–Sodexo America LLC: " I will be unavailable from late November through Christmas." (Attorney Bennett's first e-mail to GC dated July 25, 2012). "I have no objection to the November 6 date because Sodexo is not involved in the remand proceedings as the remand involves only allegations against the Hospital and the general counsel does not seek a remedy against Sodexo with respect to the remand issue relating to Hospital employee discipline." (Attorney Bennett's second e-mail to GC dated July 25, 2012).
- Charging Party–Service Workers United: no response
- Charging Party–Patricia Ortega: no response

Accordingly, GC requests that the reopening of this matter be rescheduled to November 6, 2012.
