**GENERAL COUNSEL'S CORRECTED MOTION  
TO RESCHEDULE REOPENING OF HEARING**

On July 3, 2012, the National Labor Relations Board, hereafter the Board, issued its Decision and Order in the captioned matter, wherein it remanded to the Administrative Law Judge, hereafter ALJ, the issue of four employees disciplined under Respondents' no access policy. On July 24, 2012, pursuant to the Board's remand, the ALJ issued an Order scheduling the reopening of this matter for August 13, 2012.

Counsel for the Acting General Counsel requests that the hearing be rescheduled to November 6, 2012, based on the following:

1. Counsel for the Acting General Counsel, hereafter GC, is not available on August 13, 2012, due to pre-arranged vacation plans as well as current caseload. Thus, GC's annual leave begins August 6, 2012; and, GC returns to work on August 20, 2012. Thereafter, GC is assigned to present the complaint in the *GPS Painting and Wallcovering, Inc.*, Case 21-CA-039695, scheduled to begin September 10, 2012. Thereafter, GC has pre-approved intermittent leave to observe the Jewish holidays from September 17 through October 9, 2012.

2. Respondent-USC's counsel informed the GC that she is unavailable the first half of October 2012.

3. Charging Party-NUHW's counsel informed the GC that she has a trial scheduled during the week of October 29, 2012.

4. Respondent-Sodexo's counsel informed the GC that he is unavailable from late November 2012 through Christmas, 2012. He further stated: "I have no objection to the November 6 date because Sodexo is not involved in the remand proceedings as the remand involves only allegations against the Hospital and the general counsel does not seek a remedy against Sodexo with respect to the remand issue relating to Hospital employee discipline."


5. The GC was not successful in attempts to contact Charging Party-Service Workers United or Charging Party-Patricia Ortega.

6. Respondent-USC's counsel, Charging Party-NUHW's counsel and the GC agreed that November 6, 2012 date is the first calendar date on which all parties are available. Hence, counsels for Respondent-USC and Charging Party-NUHW join in this motion.

Accordingly, GC requests that the reopening of this matter be rescheduled to November 6, 2012.


