**REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE EXCEPTIONS TO THE  
ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S DECISION**

**TO THE HONORABLE BOARD:**

**COMES NOW** Instituto Socio-Económico Comunitario, Inc., (herein called "INSEC" or the "Employer"), through the undersigned attorneys, and very respectfully states and prays as follows:

1. On August 1, 2012, Administrative Law Judge William Nelson Cates issued a decision in the above captioned cases. The decision was notified on the same date.
2. Pursuant to Section 102.46 of the NLRB's Rules and Regulations, INSEC must file exceptions to the above mentioned decision within twenty eight (28) days, that is, by August 29, 2012.
3. During the month of August the undersigned have had numerous professional commitments, including preparing for a trial scheduled for September 6, 2012, which has required immediate attention. As a result of this, it has been practically impossible for the

undersigned to draft a brief containing all the exceptions to the decision of the Administrative Law Judge within the time allotted by the NLRB's Rules and Regulations.

4. Based on the foregoing, INSEC respectfully requests an extension of time of fifteen (15) working days to file its Exceptions and Legal Brief in support before the Honorable Board. If granted, the Employer shall have until September 14, 2012 to file. The extension is sought in good faith and will not result in undue delay.

**WHEREFORE**, INSEC respectfully requests that the Honorable Board grant its request for an extension of time of fifteen (15) working days, that is, until September 14, 2012, to file its Exceptions to the Administrative Law Judge's Decision.




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
