

1 (Whereupon, General Counsel's Exhibit Numbers  
2 1A through 1KK were received into evidence.)

3 JUDGE ROSENSTEIN: Mr. Taylor, you're  
4 going to supplement that?

5 MR. TAYLOR: Yes, we will, Your  
6 Honor.

7 JUDGE ROSENSTEIN: All right. Please  
8 do so when you get all the documents compiled.

9 All right. Before I turn to the Acting  
10 General Counsel, in off-the-record discussions  
11 pursuant to a subpoena duces that was filed by the  
12 Acting General Counsel, and an order which I issued,  
13 which will be part of the record, once all the  
14 documents are compiled, I made a number of rulings.

15 I held in abeyance Items 18 and 22 of the  
16 Acting General Counsel's subpoena. And, for the  
17 record, I've directed Respondent Voith to produce, if  
18 available, any records concerning showing vehicles  
19 damaged by Respondent employees of the LAP, the  
20 Louisville Assembly Plant.

21 And Mr. Marsack indicated that if such  
22 documents exist, if they haven't already been provided  
23 to the Acting General Counsel, they would be  
24 undertaken and provided as quickly as possible.

25 With respect to Item 22, which sought

1 Dennis Franks cell phone records for any incoming or  
2 outgoing calls on April 11th of 2012, I determined  
3 that those records were not necessary and relevant as  
4 the Complaint allegation was drafted.

5 And under those circumstances, I revoked  
6 the Acting General Counsel's subpoena duces tecum as  
7 it concerned Item 22.

8 Mr. Taylor, do you have any motions that  
9 you'd like to make before proceeding with your opening  
10 statement?

11 MR. TAYLOR: Well, at this point,  
12 Your Honor, I think I would like to make a Motion to  
13 Sequester Witnesses.

14 JUDGE ROSENSTEIN: For sequestration?

15 MR. TAYLOR: Yes.

16 JUDGE ROSENSTEIN: All right. I'm  
17 assuming that there won't be any objections. But,  
18 officially, Mr. Wallington, do you have any specific  
19 objections?

20 MR. WALLINGTON: No objections to  
21 sequestration.

22 MR. MARSACK: No objections, Your  
23 Honor.

24 MS. HENRY: No objection.

25 JUDGE ROSENSTEIN: All right. Are
