Dear Mr. Heltzer:

Pursuant to Board Rule 102.46(a), Respondent Galaxy Towers Condominium Association hereby requests an additional 25 days to file exceptions to the decision of Administrative Law Judge Steven Davis in this matter. Exceptions currently are due on October 25, 2012.

The reason for this request is that counsel for Respondent Christopher Murphy has an NLRB trial in a separate matter on October 23, 2012, as well as a labor arbitration on October 18 and a mediation on October 26, 2012. Additionally, the Union and Respondent are actively engaged in the possible resolution of some of the contested issues. An extension of time will facilitate the possible private resolution of those issues.

Counsel for Respondent conferred regarding this request with Benjamin W. Green, the Counsel for the General Counsel, and Steven H. Kern, Counsel for the Union. Both parties have advised they do not object to this extension. Accordingly, Respondent respectfully requests an extension to Monday, November 19, 2012 to file exceptions in this case.
