

JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
FOR FILING EXCEPTIONS TO THE
ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S DECISION

Pursuant to §102.46 and §102.69 of the National Labor Relations Board Rules and Regulations and Statements of Procedure, Series 8, as amended, Bob's Discount Furniture of New York, LLC ("Respondent"), and Local 888, United Food and Commercial Workers International Union ("Charging Party") by their undersigned counsel, respectfully request an Extension of Time for Filing Exceptions to the Administrative Law Judge's Decision in the above captioned matter through December 21, 2012. Exceptions are currently due on December 7, 2012. This motion should be granted for the following good and sufficient reasons:

1. The Charging Party is the certified exclusive collective bargaining representative of certain bargaining units of Respondent's employees, including employees impacted by the Administrative Law Judge's Decision issued in this matter.
2. The Charging Party and Respondent have been engaged in collective bargaining negotiations regarding the units referred to in Paragraph 1, above.

3. The Charging Party and Respondent are at a critical point in negotiations and have a bargaining session scheduled for December 7, the day on which Exceptions are currently due.

4. The Charging Party and Respondent have been pursuing resolution of all outstanding issues in their relationship. These include the unfair labor practice charges relevant to the Exceptions as well as bargaining. The Parties believe this effort will be best served if they are able to meet on December 7 without being distracted by the Exceptions deadline.


5. The requested postponement, to December 21, is only two weeks and will not result in unnecessary delay if Exceptions are in fact filed.

6. Counsel for the Acting General Counsel does not oppose this Motion.




