CNN AMERICA, INC.'S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO AMEND ITS EXCEPTIONS

I. INTRODUCTION

CNN filed its exceptions to Administrative Law Judge Arthur J. Amchan's Decision in this case on February 17, 2009. CNN's Exceptions and Brief in Support of Exceptions set forth in comprehensive detail CNN's position. The Board has issued no decision on CNN's Exceptions. During the intervening years since CNN filed its Exceptions, the United States Supreme Court decided *New Process Steel, L.P. v NLRB*, 130 S. Ct. 2635 (2010) and the United States Circuit Court of Appeal for the District of Columbia decided *Noel Canning v. NLRB*, No. 12-1115, slip. op. (D.C. Cir. Jan. 25, 2013). Both of these cases have significant implications in this case. CNN, therefore, moves for leave to amend its Exceptions and requests oral argument and/or briefing on the impact of *New Process Steel* and *Noel Canning* in this case.¹

II. RECENT COURT CASES SHOULD ENABLE CNN TO AMEND ITS EXCEPTIONS AND BRIEF THE IMPLICATIONS TO THIS CASE

A. The Board Did not Have a Quorum When it Ruled on CNN's Interlocutory Appeals.

During the trial of this case, CNN filed several requests for special permission to appeal evidentiary rulings by Judge Amchan. One involved Judge Amchan's ruling that CNN produce to him documents listed on CNN's privilege log for *in camera* inspection. The Board, consisting of only two members – Peter Schaumber and Wilma Liebman – accepted CNN's request for permission to appeal but denied CNN's appeal on the merits, ordering CNN to produce the documents for *in camera* inspection. *See CNN America, Inc.*, 352 N.L.R.B. 448 (2008). Another request involved Judge Amchan's ruling that CNN produce documents protected by the reporter's privilege. The Board, again consisting of only two members – Peter Schaumber and Wilma

Moreover, in making this Motion, CNN does not concede that the Board as presently constituted is empowered to enter any decisions in light of *Noel Canning v NLRB*, and as explained below submits that the NLRB has been acting without a quorum since August 27, 2011.

Liebman – granted permission to appeal but ruled against CNN on the merits as well. *See CNN America, Inc.*, 352 N.L.R.B. 675 (2008). CNN argued in its Exceptions to Judge Amchan’s Decision that these Board rulings were not issued by a quorum of a properly constituted three-member panel. *See CNN’s Exceptions to Administrative Law Judge Arthur J. Amchan’s Decision* at 327 (Exception No. 120) and 328 (No. 126).

On June 17, 2010, the United States Supreme Court ruled in *New Process Steel, L.P. v. National Labor Relations Board*, 130 S. Ct. 2635 (2010), that the nearly 600 decisions made by the two-member Board from January 2008 to March 2010 were invalid because the Board lacked a proper quorum. Such a definitive answer from the Supreme Court of the United States on the very issue raised by CNN in its Exceptions constitutes an extraordinary circumstance warranting an amendment to CNN’s Exceptions and additional briefing.

Immediately following the issuance of the decision in *New Process Steel*, on June 28, 2010, CNN specifically requested in a letter addressed to the Board’s Associate Executive Secretary the opportunity to brief the impact of the Supreme Court’s decision in this case. That request was opposed and eventually denied.² Given the importance of the Supreme Court’s decision in *New Process Steel* and its implications on this case, CNN respectfully and now formally renews its request to brief that issue and its implications on this case as well as the right to amend its exceptions to Judge Amchan’s Decision.

B. Pursuant to the D.C. Circuit’s Decision in *Noel Canning*, The Board Lacks a Quorum and Cannot Act.

On January 25, 2013, the D.C. Circuit Court Appeals, in *Noel Canning v. National Labor Relations Board*, ___ F.3d ___, 2013 WL 276024 (D.C. Cir. January 25, 2013), held that President Obama’s “recess” appointments of Members Block, Griffin and Flynn to the Board were

unconstitutional. The D.C. Circuit Court of Appeals determined, in the *Noel Canning* case, that none of the three recess appointments was valid and thus, under *New Process Steel*, the Board lacked a quorum and its decision in *Noel Canning* was void.

Again, immediately after issuance of the D.C. Circuit's decision in *Noel Canning*, on January 30, 2013, CNN sent a letter to the Board's Acting Executive Secretary requesting permission to brief the issues raised in both *Noel Canning* and *New Process Steel*, as well as the inevitable implications of those decisions on this case.³ While CNN has not yet received a response, the implications of these two decisions on this case compels CNN to preserve all its rights regarding the impact of these issues on its exceptions to Judge Amchan's ruling below.

Additionally, given the decision in *Noel Canning v NLRB*, CNN submits that the Board cannot rely on any decision rendered since August 27, 2011, as those decisions, under the reasoning in *Noel-Canning* and *New Process Steel*, are ultra vires because they were not issued by the Board with a lawful quorum. CNN further submits that in light of these precedents, the Board has been acting without a quorum since August 27, 2011 may not issue any further decisions until a lawful quorum is assembled. Submission of this motion is not intended to and should not be construed as a waiver of any objection to any action by the Board conducted without a quorum under the standards established in *Noel Canning* and *New Process Steel*.

III. CONCLUSION

For the reasons stated above and in the extraordinary circumstances that have occurred, CNN respectfully requests the right to file the attached Amended Exceptions⁴ and the opportunity to brief the implications to this case raised in the decisions in *New Process Steel* and *Noel Canning*.

We are counsel for CNN America in the above-referenced cases. We write with regards to the recent United States Supreme Court decision, *New Process Steel, L.P. v. National Labor Relations Board*, 560 U.S. ____ (June 17, 2010). As the National Labor Relations Board ("the Board") is aware, the Supreme Court in *New Process Steel* held that any decision issued by Members Liebman and Shaumber as a two-member Board, during the period of January 1, 2008 through March 27, 2010, was invalid and without authority.

Given the holding in *New Process Steel*, CNN hereby requests permission to brief the impact of this decision on the CNN matter currently pending at the Board. Moreover, to the extent the Board intends to revisit any of the issues decided by the two-member Board in the CNN matter, CNN requests the right to brief specifically any of those issues before the Board renders a decision.

Please be advised that CNN has informed the Court in a related enforcement action, *National Labor Relations Board v. CNN America, Inc.*, 08 CV M18-304 (S.D.N.Y., filed June 26, 2008), that the Board decision the General Counsel seeks to enforce (352 NLRB No. 64) in that matter is null and void and that the enforcement action should be dismissed.

**CNN'S AMENDED EXCEPTIONS TO
ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE ARTHUR J. AMCHAN'S DECISION**

Pursuant to Section 102.46 of the Rules and Regulations of the National Labor Relations Board and in light of the United States Supreme Court's decision in *New Process Steel, L.P. v. NLRB*, 130 S. Ct. 2635 (2010) and the United States Circuit Court of Appeal for the District of Columbia's decision in *Noel Canning v. NLRB*, No. 12-1115, slip. op. (D.C. Cir. Jan. 25, 2013), CNN respectfully files the following AMENDED exceptions to the November 19, 2008 Decision of Administrative Law Judge Arthur J. Amchan.¹

¹ References to the ALJ's Decision are identified by page and line numbers, as "D. __, L. __." References to the hearing transcript are identified by the official transcript page number and line numbers, as "Tr. __, L. __." In most if not all cases there are multiple Record citations that support each exception. Given the volume of the Record in this case, CNN cites only to the principle citations related to the exceptions.

CNN incorporates by reference as if stated in full herein its Exceptions to Administrative Law Judge Arthur J. Amchan's Decision, originally filed on February 17, 2009.²

I. EXCEPTIONS

A. Exceptions to Rulings on CNN's Assertions of Attorney Client and/or Work Product Privilege

1. To the Board's ruling (*CNN America, Inc.*, 352 N.L.R.B. 448 (2008)) affirming the ALJ's ruling at Tr. 7687, L.1-6 regarding the production of privileged documents for *in camera* review, as such ruling is null and void because it was issued by a two-member panel that the United States Supreme Court has held in *New Process Steel, L.P. v. NLRB*, 130 S. Ct. 2635 (2010) lacked authority to act.

B. Exceptions to Rulings on CNN's Assertions of Reporter's Privilege

2. To the Board's ruling (*CNN America, Inc.*, 352 N.L.R.B. No. 85 (May 30, 2008)) affirming the ALJ's ruling at Tr. 16291, L.8-10, regarding CNN's assertion of reporter's privilege, as such ruling is null and void because it was issued by a two-member panel that the United States Supreme Court has held in *New Process Steel, L.P. v. NLRB*, 130 S. Ct. 2635 (2010) lacked authority to act.

II. CONCLUSION




