DECISION AND CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

The National Labor Relations Board has considered objections to a mail ballot election held between November 13 and December 4, 2012, and the Regional Director's report recommending disposition of them. The election was conducted pursuant to a Stipulated Election Agreement. The tally of ballots shows 0 ballots cast for the Petitioner, 5 ballots cast for the Intervenor,¹ and 0 ballots cast against the participating labor organizations. There were 2 void ballots and 0 challenged ballots, an insufficient number to affect the results.

No exceptions have been filed to the Regional Director's report within the time provided. Accordingly, the Board adopts the Regional Director's findings and recommendations, and finds that a certification of representative should be issued.
