ORDER

On May 27, 2010, the Board issued a Decision and Certification of Representative in Case 34-RC-2205. Subsequently, on October 29, 2010, the Board issued a Decision and Order in Case 34-CA-12735, which is reported at 356 NLRB No.10.

On November 1, 2010, the Respondent filed a petition for review of the Board's Decision and Order in the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia. The record is due to be filed on January 19, 2011.

Upon further consideration, pursuant to Section 10(d) of the National Labor Relations Act, the Board hereby vacates and sets aside its October 29, 2010 Decision and Order.¹ The Board will retain this case on its docket and take further action as appropriate.
